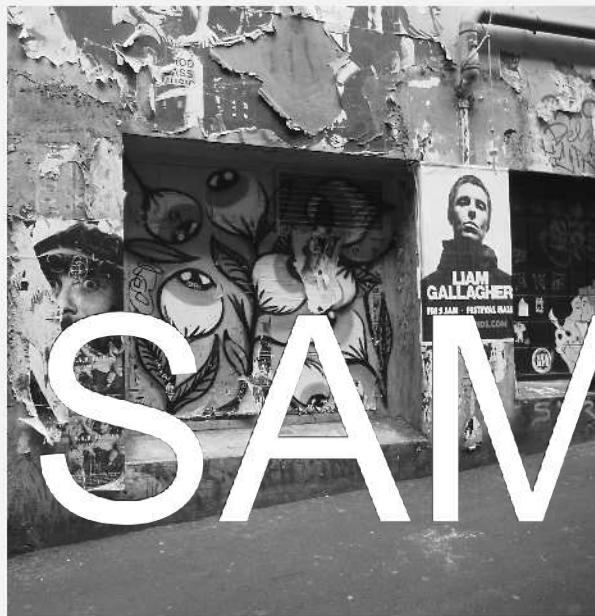




## FEDERATION SQUARE

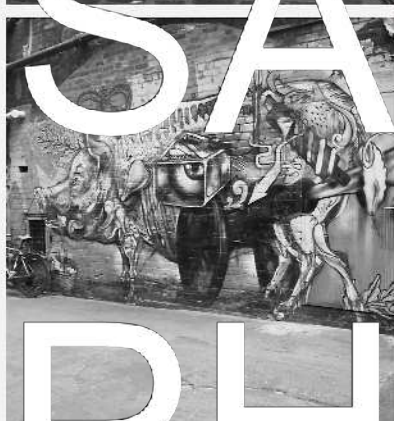
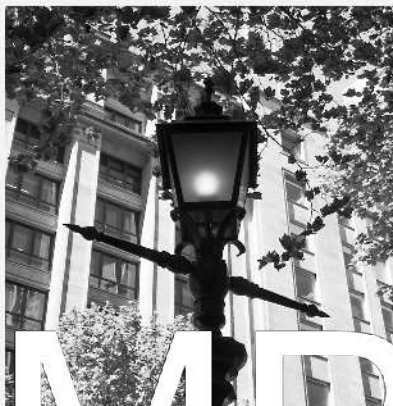
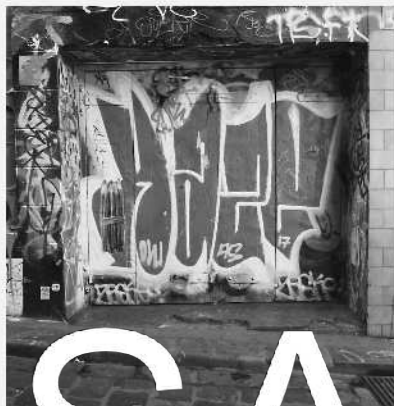

Many of Melbourne's most noteworthy precincts and prominent buildings face Swanston Street as the city's historic main avenue.

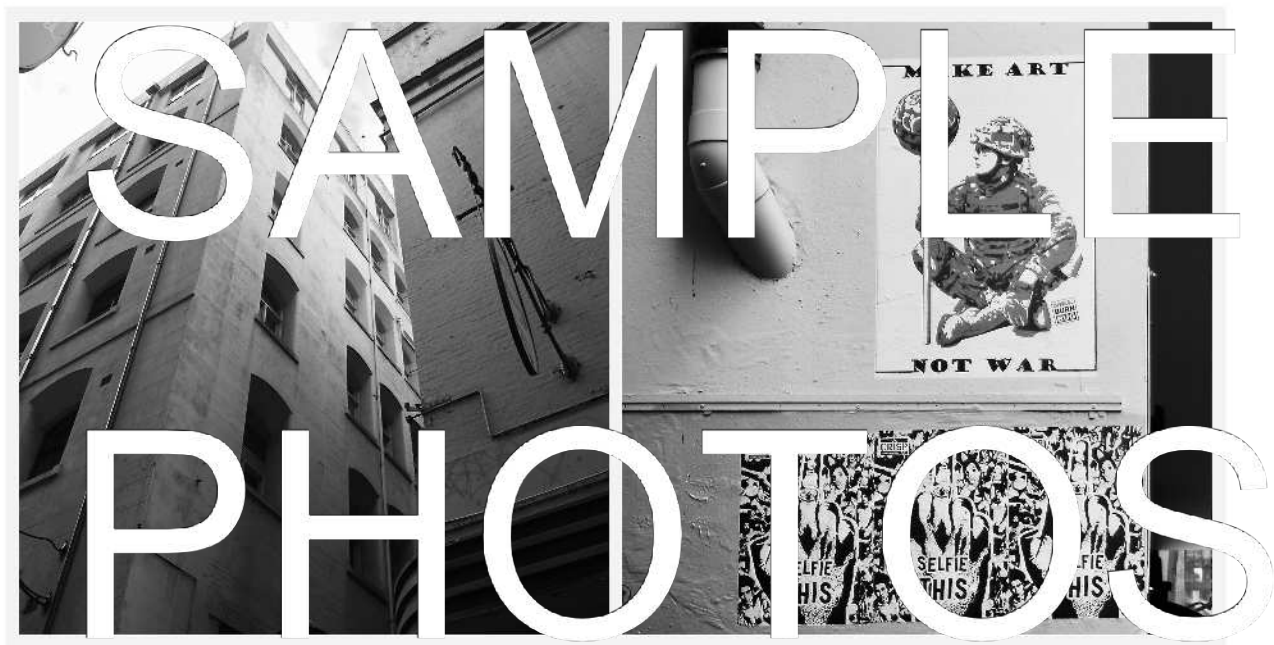

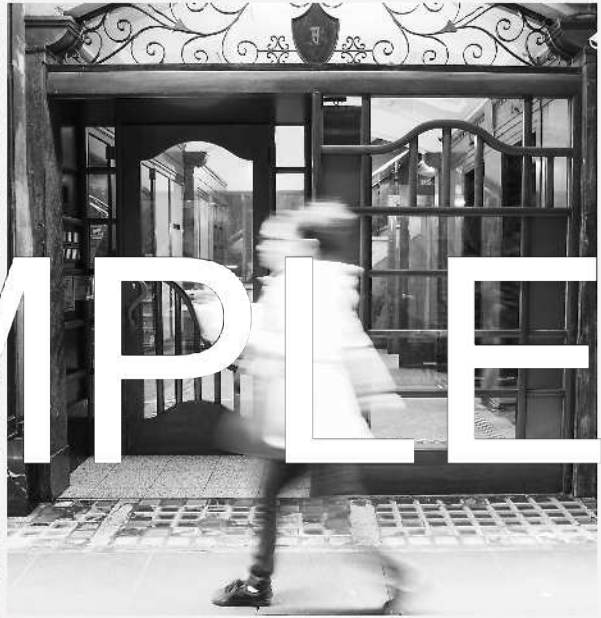
